


Østgarðrians love to work on their Arts & Sciences projects!



◀Left: Selbu mittens by Lady Catelin Straquhin. Selbuvott mittens are a 19th-century form of mittens that originate from Selbu, Norway. Originally designed by Marit Guldsetbrua Emstad in 1857, the traditional mitten design is inspired by the Selburose, a knitted rose pattern in the shape of an octagram. The Selburose is also featured in the Coat of Arms of Selbu, Norway.
