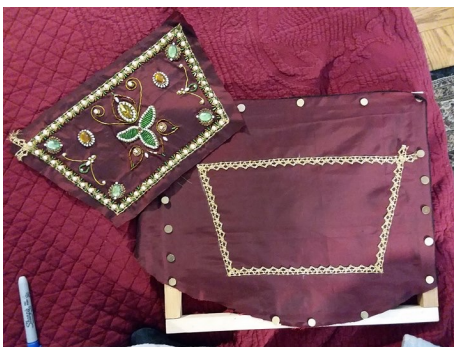
## Workshops, etc.

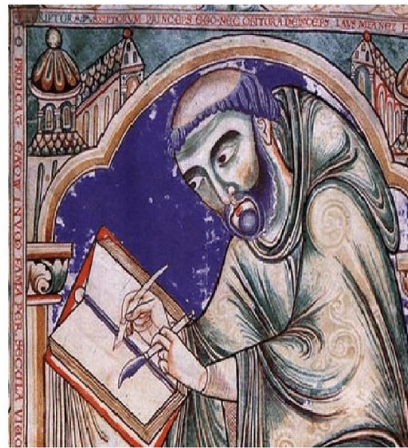
