OCTOBER 2019 MINUTES • ØSTGARÐR COMMONS

In lieu of minutes, the E·Horse has elected to publish this abridged history by Provincial Historian Sofya Gianetta di Trieste.

September 7, 2019: Feast of John Barleycorn

The Viceregents delivered an Award of Arms ordered by their Majesties East for Meadhbh O'Gairbhith. Buenaventura Miguel Rivera and Galen Mac Byrne were inducted into the Order of the Sea Dog. Conandil ingen Donngaile was made a member of the Order of the Silver Lantern in recognition of her artistry and her service. Catelin Straquhin stepped down as Provincial Archery Champion passing the title to Mongu Chinua.

September 22nd, 2019

An announcement came from the Kingdom of Acre to be wary of Count Rakkurai (Barry Green), a registered level three sex offender. This was quickly brought to the attention of our Provincial Senechal, who notified her superiors as well as the public without prior approval from her superiors.

September 23rd, 2019

The East Kingdom Seneschal sent the following words regarding the expulsion of Count Rakkurai:

"The Society Seneschal has issued an expulsion from the Society to Barry Greene, Sr., known in the Society as Count Rakkurai, on September 23rd, 2019."

September 24th, 2019

The Populace was notified that Alienor Salton was no longer Seneschal.

September 26, 2019

In answer to the growing anger and frustration from the people of Østgarðr and the East Kingdom regarding Alienor's removal as Seneschal and the manner in which information was distributed to the Populace, the Kingdom Seneschal and Royals sent these words:

"(T)he Society Seneschal and the Kingdom Seneschal of the East...expedited the expulsion of (Count Rakkurai) from the SCA on Monday, September 23, 2019. The Society Seneschal sent a certified mail notification of his expulsion the same day. Second, substantial misinformation has circulated about the removal of a local officer within the East Kingdom. This person left office after willingly disobeying a directive to not act until we had completed the sanction process, which includes populace notification. Contact with the offender is the sole domain of the Kingdom Seneschal and/or the Society Seneschal... The officer was NOT removed because they reported the offender to the Society, Officers, and the populace. When an officer bypasses the rules of our sanction process by willfully ignoring directives, the process may be compromised while Kingdom and Corporate officers are attempting to manage the sanction process. ...(R)emoval was not done lightly nor were the actions which removed the officer in question light in the potential to disrupt the ongoing sanction investigation and process."

September 28th: St. Andrew Crosses the Alps in the Barony of An Dubh

Alexander MacLachlan was inducted into the Order of the Silver Rapier. Sofya Gianetta di Trieste was recognized as Seamstress to the Crown. Edward Zifran of Gendy received a Queen's Order of Courtesy. Mathghamhain Ua Ruadháin and Brandr Aronsson received Burdened Tygers for their work on the Coronation.

September 29th: Østgarðr at the Cloisters

The populace of the Crown Province of Østgarðr gathered and shared their skills at the Cloisters Medieval Demo. Surrounded by a large cheering crowd the Provincial Fencing Championship and the Heavy Weapons Championships were chosen.

Muiredach Ua Dálaigh James Ua Dálaig was named Heavy Weapons Champion, inspired to great deeds by Alienor Salton and named her the Provincial Queen of Love and Beauty; Engle der Pfau was named the new Fencing Champion. Vivat to all!

October 6th, 2019 Last Court of King Ozurr and Queen Fortune at the Coronation of Their Heirs King Ozurr and Queen Fortune graciously acknowledged Suuder Saran with Queen's Order of Courtesy and King's Esteem, Lada Monguligin with King's Esteem, Sofya Gianetta di Trieste as Clothier to the Crown and with the The King's Cypher.

October 5th, A.S. LIV (2019) First Court of Their Majesties el Rey Luis and la Reina Margarita in the Shire of Montevale at the Coronation of Luis and Margarita

Their Majesties elevated Ozurr the Bootgiver to the rank of Count, sent him on vigil and elevated to the Order of the Chivalry later that afternoon.

Their Majesties issued a Royal Sanction of Exile against Richard the Poor of Ely.

October 12, 2019

His Majesty Luis abdicated the throne. Shortly after, Queen Margarita sent the following words:

"Thank you for the outpouring of messages of support I have received today. I am deeply moved by your love and kindness. I will serve this Kingdom that I love and you, My populace. I ask you to please respect My privacy, and please be patient with Me. This is a difficult time for us all. My heart goes out to all those affected."

That same day, the Board of Directors expelled Luis R. Rondon, known in the Society as Luis de Castille. Below are the words from the Board of Directors.

"Unto the Society, on October 12th, 2019 the Society Seneschal expelled Luis R. Rondon, known in the Society as Luis de Castille, from the Society for Creative Anachronism. This is due to a criminal investigation of Mr. Rondon. ... The Board is reviewing all of the information regarding the situation and will be issuing further statements when possible."

Return of the Cloved Kruit

Where has the cloved fruit gone? In my early years in the SCA, I was introduced to the

tradition of the cloved fruit game. People were passing an orange around that had a bunch of whole cloves sticking out of it. I asked one of my friends about the game and was given a brief explanation. This tradition seems to have gone away because some found it creepy. Truth be told, the game is very much permission based and therefore, quite appropriate for the current culture.

Historical Significance

In the middle ages, fresh citrus fruit and spices were often very expensive. Gifting a cloved fruit was considered a show of wealth. On the practical side, these were usually hung from an individual's belt as an air freshener and believed to be a way of keeping away the plague.

Cloved Fruit-the Rules

- The fruit is handed from one individual to another, usually offered with a compliment.
- Upon accepting the fruit, the receiver removes a clove and offers up a body part to be kissed, based on their own comfort level.*
- The giver, having been given permission, proceeds with the kiss.
- 4. The receiver has now become the giver and should pass it to someone they respect and/or admire.
- 5. Receiver may also verbally express where or if they should be kissed.

* Some versions denote type of kiss, based on how a clove is removed from the fruit and what is done with it. See Rules Variant below.

Rules Variant—regarding removal of clove

If the receiver:

- Refuses cloved fruit: acceptable way of saying don't want to play.
- 2. Removes clove by hand and discards: a rejection and considered to be antisocial and discourteous.
- Removes clove by hand and holds out palm down: a kiss on the hand.
- 4. Removes clove by hand and holds out palm up: a kiss on the wrist.
- 5. Removes clove by mouth and transfers to hand: a kiss on the cheek.
- 6. Removes clove by mouth and holds it between teeth with lips closed: a kiss on the cheek.
- 7. Removes clove by mouth and holds it between teeth with lips open: a kiss on the lips. There is still a fair amount of decorum here and the kiss should be brief.

- 8. Removes by mouth and holds clove inside mouth: kiss usually between significant others or potential lovers.
- 9. Accepts cloved fruit, then drops it or rolls it back: highly insulting, like a slap in the face.
- 10. Accepts cloved fruit, receives kiss, and returns orange to giver: a great compliment, considered a gesture of romantic interest.
- 11. Giver presents cloved fruit with a single clove remaining: considered an offer of sex.

If you are unsure of receiver's intention, please ask. This game is not an excuse for bad behavior. Please respect individuals' personal space and level of comfort.

Starting December 1st, and going through December 14th, residents of the Province will be able to go online and vote for the positions of **Provincial Seneschal** and **Provincial Herald**. Voting will be open to all (1) paid members, (2) who reside within the Province and its Cantons, and (3) are at least 14 years old.

Voting will be done using the "Borda Method". This is a ranked voting system. People will pick out their first choice of candidate for the position and this will be recorded when their form is submitted. You will then get an email confirming your choices.

I will be verifying whether people are eligible to vote. Our Viceregents will have access to the actual votes.

If your membership has expired recently, and you have renewed, please print out a copy of your renewal and send it to me when you vote.

In addition, there are five other provincial officer positions that will only be voted on by the officers through email, as there is only one candidate for each of them. These are: Minister of Lists, Minister of A&S, Fencing Marshal, Historian and Webminister. Officers, please check your gmail accounts.

Candidate statements for Herald and Seneschal (that were posted on Facebook) are re-printed here in the E-Horse (see below).

Below is a list of all the Candidates. People can ask them questions directly, even if they are only being voted on by the officers. If anybody has a concern about any of the candidates, they should contact either the <u>Viceregents</u> or <u>myself</u>.

Officer Statements

Seneschal

Alexander MacLachlan

I have been in the Society for 30 years. I have served in several officer posts: Baronial and Canton Seneschal, Chatelaine, Chronicler, Acting Knight Marshal, and Fencing Marshal. I have autocrated several events, including King's and Queen's Bardic Championship. I feel that I can use this experience to help support and guide the Province in its future endeavors.

I have served in the Province for almost the last two years as the Provincial Deputy Seneschal and am currently the Acting Seneschal. In that capacity I have tried to be an additional means for members of the populace to communicate with the officer corps, and provide whatever support I can throughout the Province. I feel I have demonstrated an ability to work with people who have varied interests to get things done.

With these in mind, some things that I want to do include:

- Develop new demos and workshops where we show our best skills and manners, not just to fulfill our mandate to educate the public, but also to attract new members.
- Foster new events and develop new venues to generate interest and get current members to participate more in the Province. Likewise, we can not afford to commit our time and effort in major projects that yield little results (such as an event that has extremely low attendance). We always have to look at events to see how we can make them better.
- Support the Provincial officers in their endeavors.
- Help Northpass become a group that will prosper, as it has in the past.

These, along with the general administration of the Province, require not just being a leader, but also working with everyone from the Viceregals and Provincial officers to the populace.

Hlæfdige Alienor Salton (known as Piglet)

I submit myself as a candidate for the position of seneschal of Østgarðr. I believe by now you all know me and what I am prepared to do for the province.

From my letter of intent when I ran for my first term as seneschal:

"My goal as provincial Seneschal will be to increase participation at all levels, by...facilitating communication, supporting provincial officers in doing their jobs, and making local activities more transparent & accessible and welcoming to new & old members alike. I will also work to encourage participation out of province, seeking out nearby & further events relevant to our local members' interest, and publicizing and facilitating group excursions thereto."

To accomplish these goals in my first term, I streamlined our commons meetings and recruited new talent to invigorate our officer corps. I brought transparency and efficiency to our provincial communications by introducing pre-Commons written officer reports, published along with full minutes after each meeting. I expanded our event listing, also published after each meeting, to highlight out of province events of interest to our populace.

I also urged on the work of the bylaws committee, which concluded with a successful ratification of our new provincial bylaws—a milestone in provincial history.

I would like to carry on this work in a second term with the following four initiatives:

- Continue to diversify the officer corps by recruiting new talent so we have the breadth and depth to share the labor across officer volunteers.
- 2. Encourage activity within and beyond the province so our new & old members alike are more involved at home and "abroad" and better connected with each other and our neighbors. Facilitate more casual, regular, social cross-interest gatherings (like the Whyt Whey solars, the Brokenbridge Commons, the Northpass A&S/gaming days, and the bardic/fencing evening) to enhance provincial community. Arrange road

- trips to events further afield to connect with our neighbors and fellow citizens of the East.
- Sort out a less ad-hoc provincial storage solution, easing the burden of storing, maintaining and deploying our gold key, kitchen gear, loaner armor (iron key), etc. (pavilions, list ropes, banners...).
- 4. Encourage new & different events, with more immersion and other thematic activities, broadening the pool of successful event stewards, and finishing a provincial event steward handbook and an event site database.

From me, the job of provincial seneschal has included attending canton commons, preparing for & following up on provincial commons, communicating with kingdom officers, supporting local officers, and making things run smoothly for the populace. Over the last two years as your provincial seneschal, I have spent 40–60 hours a month in your service. I am committed to doing so again for the next 2 years, if you will have me.
